\$210 in revenue sharing from Gerry's book was received today.

President and Executive Director's Reports – Agenda attached.

1) Education

Gerry – SEL update – School 4x this year. Next program starts Monday. Alzheimer Association with our support will be conducting. Same program as Spring. Excited about Music Therapy Program.

VDT Prospects

Fulton Country Library System – dormant since August, meeting still on for October.

Walden's Cove — trading emails, expressed interest in training after attending VDT $\,$

United Community Bank – difficult trying to get into banks, cutting back on expenditures, could also be staff reluctance.

Discussion about moving towards professional VDT (bankers, lawyers, insurance, etc.). Need to build champions of VDT to interest for company specific programs. John Copenhaver recommended approaching attorneys. Doug Hansen mentioned that may eat at Longstreet, maybe have Tim talk with them about the VDT we did for his staff and value of it.

Longstreet Café – September 17 - 18, 2-4:30

Need 5 volunteers, will be double time running 4 people through VDT at a time. Initial plan was for day 2 to be for lecture, present some hands on training bussing table, filling drinks, etc. No immediate follow up with community members. Questions about how to publicize (WCON, Access WDUN).

2) Symposium -

160 current registrants.

Budget now \$16,669. AV may come in low. Sarah (guitar player with music therapy degree) will provide music. Helping Hand's donation will be shifted to cover other expenses.

Symposium expenses — bottom line is that we are currently within \$50 to cover all expenses regarding symposium. Need to raise \$3000 to not drain BDC funds.

Bill Papciak & Cresswind Foundation approved \$300 for volunteer meals @ Symposium.

Ashton Place and Anne Bishop both committed to sponsoring tables (\$250) at Symposium.

15 current exhibitors, some paid, some in lieu of honorarium.

Social media posts being resent to board members for reposting.

Question for Bruce about how many people try to sign up and then abandon? Cloud responded that it is approximately one in 12 that have problems.

Discussion about Facebook advertising prior to event. Plan is to approach Alz Assoc to cover cost and handle.

Update from Gerry about volunteers and organization of them. Working with Stacy on that. Good base signed up, still in flux somewhat. Need 5-10 more.

Debrief on event will be Sept. 30th at 2:30, location TBD. Bill, Cloud, Gerry and Stacy will attend. Others welcome.

3) Governance
